DAILY BIBLE READINGS SEPTEMBER 29 – OCTOBER 5

In the readings this week we will review the seven churches of Revelation, which we studied during August and September. Next Sunday we will begin a new series on the ten foundational values that under-gird our church's Vision 2015.

As you read about each church, consider: (1) What does Jesus reveal about himself? (2) What strengths of that church does he identify? (3) What weaknesses does he point out? (4) What encouraging promises does he provide? (5) What warnings does he give? (5) What is Jesus trying to say to you personally?

Pray for our church, and for the other churches in New England, and in particular, the Baptist Convention of New England. Pray for Dr. Jim Wideman as he guides the staff of BCNE, and encourages the churches. Pray that each congregation would be able to hear God's message to them, and would become a seedbed for spiritual awakening in our region.
